Dr Ruth Casey is a Consultant Endocrinologist in Cambridge University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and holds an academic position as a senior research fellow in the Department of Medical Genetics, Cambridge University. Dr Casey leads neuroendocrine tumour (NET) and endocrine cancer services in Cambridge and is the endocrine lead for the endocrine genetics service, encompassing both clinical practice and independently-funded research in GIST, pheochromocytoma and paraganglioma. She has a specialist research interest in SDH deficient tumours and the molecular mechanisms underpinning endocrine cancers. Dr Casey is also the clinical convenor for the Society for Endocrinology Endocrine Cancer Network and a member of the SDH consortium.
